Lower Hybrid - K - 4th - 9:00 - 2:00 Options: M/W or T/TH or M/T/W or M/W/TH or T or TH

Select from one to four days of attendance! Our program provides instruction in the core subjects using a relaxed and fun approach. Our mornings consist of leveled math, multisensory reading instruction using the Orton Gillingham approach, and ELA. Afternoons consist of theme-based units in science and social studies, plus hands-on explorations in STEM, world cultures, and art. Our kids enjoy a 30 minute morning recess and hour lunch break in our outdoor green space!



Upper Hybrid - 4th - 8th - 8:45 - 2:45 Options: T/TH, T/TH/F or Friday Only

Students in the Upper Hybrid program may select from one to three days of attendance. Our **T/TH hybrid** offers engaging, standards-based instruction in the core skills, including leveled math, reading, ELA, science, and social studies. **Fridays** complement our hybrid program, offering foundational math, writing and composition, lab-style science, and deep dives into world cultures. The Friday program creates a comprehensive experience when paired with the T/TH hybrid; it can also be used as an "essentials" program to meet GA requirements for "instruction in the core subjects". Home study assignments will be required, but individualized to each student's ability.



High School - Fridays - 8:45 - 2:45 Algebra 1, Biology, & English 1

Our **full day** high school program is designed for students desiring in-person instruction in the mandated subjects in a relaxed and individualized setting. In-person lessons are paired with home study assignments to ensure students meet credit-level proficiency. Students will select a 'standard' or 'honors' track based their academic goals.



Friday Literacy Intensive - ages 7+ 9:00 - 12:00 or 9:00 - 2:00

Succeeding in Reading is designed for readers who could benefit from a full morning of literacy-based activities using highly acclaimed, evidence-based programs such as an **Orton Gillingham** approach for decoding/spelling; Lindamood Bell's Visualizing and Verbalizing for comprehension & higher order thinking, plus our own curated curriculum for literature and composition.
